



Mission Types

Wings of Compassion, through donations from our mission partners, will provide the following types of missions.

Mission: To transport non emergency medical patients for medical care away from home and to unite families separated by illness and injury. Primarily concentrating on children with severe injury or illness, such as burn victims, Wings of Compassion provides free flights to those in need to help meet appointment demands. For most of these patients a long distance car ride can be very uncomfortable and difficult for both child and family members.

Mission: To assist in natural disaster relief within 500 miles of our base in Panama City, Florida. Hurricane Katrina demonstrated the need for emergency supplies and medical aid in an event of a natural disaster. Wings of Compassion will provide assistance with flights of emergency supplies into smaller airports not served by the large airline jets and cargo carriers. Families displaced by these disasters can also be transported to nearby relatives for housing and other assistance.

Mission: Support missionary services in the islands of the Caribbean and Haiti. Flight will consist of flying missionaries, medical supplies, food and dental teams working to help needy people of the region. Our goal is to make three to four missionary flights a year.

Mission: Discover flights for “at risk” kids to introduce them to the world of aviation.

Mission: Spouse abuse shelters assisting in the relocation of battered spouses and their children

Mission: Provide transportation to injured Military Veterans to Veterans Retreat in South Florida.
